Segment 1. As outlined by the Department of State, JSJT will conduct 24 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction in a dual-controlled automobile, fully insured, which covers each student enrolled in the program. The student must be at least 14 years 8 months of age by the beginning of class (verification by birth certificate required). Requirements to passing the course and receiving the Segment 1 certificate are based on the student completing the classroom instruction and behind-the-wheel instruction noted herein, and achieving a minimum score of 80% on the Segment 1 Knowledge Test. Segment 1 tuition is \$395.00. To reserve a seat in a class, a deposit of \$197.50 is required, with the balance due the first day of class.

Segment 2. As outlined by the Department of State, JSJT will conduct a minimum of 6 hours of classroom instruction in defensive driving strategies. Prior to attending class, the student must have a Level 1 License for at least 90 days and have received 30 hours of the required 50 hours of behind-the-wheel time with a parent or designated licensed adult over the age of 21, including 2 of the required 10 hours of night driving. Requirements to passing the course and receiving the Segment 2 certificate are based on the student completing the classroom instruction noted herein, and demonstrating the ability to execute proper defensive driving habits while operating a vehicle. A tuition fee of \$100.00 is due prior to, or on, the first day of class.

Agreement

Method of Payment: Final/full payment due on the first day of class—JSJT will accept cash, check, money order, or credit card for the full amount of tuition. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Refunds: JSJT will not refund any fee, tuition, charges, or any part thereof should we be ready, willing, and able to fulfill our part of the services. Postponement or cancellation of driving sessions must be made within 24 hours of the scheduled appointment to the instructor. Failure to do so may result in the student being charged a fee of \$35.00. This fee will be paid in full before any additional lessons are received. We reserve the right to cancel, postpone, or reschedule classes or lessons at our sole discretion. If a student is unable to complete a program, the tuition received will be credited toward the next program of their choice. If a student is removed from class for misbehavior, credit will not be given.

Miscellaneous Information: Students need to arrive on time to all activities. Excessive tardiness will result in removal from class. Five (5) minutes late equals one tardy; three (3) tardies and the student will be dismissed from class. Students need to be prepared for class with pens, pencils, and notebooks.

According to 1998 PA 11, a written agreement must be obtained from a parent or legal guardian in order for a driving school to have permission for a student to accompany the driving instructor if there is less than one (1) other student in the car during driving instructions.
